AGRICULTURE

1 *One goat*

\$50

The gift of a goat improves a family's nutrition and can generate income that helps our partners lift themselves out of poverty -- providing money for food, health care, and education. The gift of one goat can eventually benefit a whole community.



2 *One cow*

\$250

The gift of a cow helps increase a family's calcium and protein intake and surplus milk can be sold at the local market providing the family with needed income as well. Manure can be added to the garden as fertilizer. The gift of a cow has widespread benefits that will keep on giving day after day.



3 *FAITH garden*

\$25

FAITH (Food Always In The Home) gardening allows a family to have sufficient food to eat on a daily basis. Sometimes more food is harvested than is needed, allowing the family to sell their surplus at the market. BGR partners teach families how to grow the FAITH gardens; you provide the seed and fertilizer to get them started!



4 *Micro-irrigation system*

\$100

A micro-irrigation system makes sure a family's crops are receiving the water they need to grow. Crops will have a better chance of survival in dry areas, where water supplies are limited or water is expensive, and a better yield during harvest. Families will have food to eat, food to store, & surplus food to sell for income!



5

Stock one fish pond

\$50

Food resources are always an issue when available farmland is limited. Your gift will help construct a fish pond and stock it with 500 fingerling fish that provide income and improve nutrition for a family. Farmers learn how to manage and harvest the ponds, allowing fish to reproduce for many years.



6

One farmer's tool kit

\$25

Acres of erosion-prone hillside can be turned into farmland without risk to the environment. Your gift of a farmer's tool kit will help BGR partners train farmers in SALT (Sloping Agricultural Land Technology) This method transforms unused hill-sides into working farms – producing both food and income.



7

Veterinarian medical kit

\$50

Maintaining animal health in a rural community is very important. By providing basic veterinarian education and a medical kit to an animal worker, you will help the community prevent and treat diseases in livestock – the source of their livelihood. - by ensuring their animals are healthy and productive.



8

A pair of rabbits

\$25

In many places, rabbits can be a great source of family nutrition and income. They are easy to raise and multiply quickly, allowing a family to have quick access to protein and income. Your gift of \$25 will help place a male and female rabbit with a deserving family.



9

Chickens

\$15

Help a farm family get a start in raising quality chickens. Chickens can be raised for their eggs, giving good nutrition and a reliable income source for the family. Your gift of \$15 will help place 20 chicks with a needy family.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

1 *Self-help project*

\$100

As BGR teams train national partners in community development, seed money in small amounts can help provide capital for their initial projects. These projects are chosen by the community and are often their first step out of poverty.



2

Transportation for development worker

\$1000

This amount will provide one year of basic transportation for a national partner community development worker. This will allow them to access and work among the communities where they have been assigned.



3

Training for development in a village

\$1000

Your gift will provide a three- to five-day community development workshop for up to 20 villagers. The gift will help cover the cost of food and materials for participants. This training will give community members skills and tools to help them take charge of their future development.



4

Sponsor a local partner in community training

\$50

Your gift will help cover the cost of food and materials for a participant. This training will give a community member skills and tools to help them guide future development.



DISASTER RESPONSE

1

Feed a family of 5 for 1 week during disaster \$50

Instead of bringing food from the outside that is often more costly (due to shipping) and, in many cases, not culturally appropriate, BGR works with partners to provide locally purchased and culturally appropriate food staples. Your gift will help meet one family's need for one week during a catastrophic event.



2

Water for one day per family \$2

Clean drinking water is generally the most immediate need during a catastrophic event. This small gift will provide essential water to families who have experienced a disaster. A gift of \$10 will provide water to a family for a week.



3

Temporary shelter for family \$250

After a disaster occurs, temporary shelter is often the most needed item once water and food needs are met. Your gift will provide a temporary shelter, such as a locally made tent or tarpaulin, to protect disaster survivors from the weather.



4

Permanent shelter for family \$2000

BGR believes in transitioning to permanent housing as quickly as possible. We work with communities to determine locally accepted and culturally appropriate homes that can be rebuilt with locally available materials. We generally help a family secure a one to two room shelter home that can be expanded by the family when they obtain the resources to do so.



5

One cooking set

\$45

When a massive disaster occurs, people need access to basic cooking facilities and utensils. Your gift will provide a cooking set for one family in need.



6

One month's supply of wood

\$100

Once food is provided to disaster survivors, wood often is needed for cooking fuel. In colder climates, wood also provides heat. Your gift will help supply fuel wood or other locally available fuels (i.e. coal, propane, etc.) for a family severely affected by a disaster.



7

Blankets for a family

\$50

In colder climates, disaster survivors need blankets to help them overcome the cold. This gift will help BGR provide provide warm blankets for a family in need.



EDUCATION

1

5 exercise books for a child

\$5

In Sub-Saharan Africa, many children are required to have standardized workbooks to attend school. Many of these children live in poverty and cannot afford even these simple items. Your gift will ensure that a child can go to school with the supplies he needs to be successful.



2 *25 textbooks for a school* \$100

In developing countries, schools and families cannot provide textbooks for children. Your gift will help children have access to textbooks, not only for one year, but for years to come.



3 *School kit for a child* \$15

Basic school essentials such as pencils, paper, erasers and glue are often taken for granted by children in developed countries, yet simple items like this can make a big difference in getting a successful education. Your gift will help bless a child in a developing country who does not have access to such supplies.



4 *Child's education for one year* \$250

Help keep a child in school! Your gift will provide basic school supplies, uniforms and shoes for a needy child in a developing country.



HEALTH CARE

1 *Stock hospital medications for one month* \$2,500

Many hospitals in developing countries are in need of basic medicines. Many of these hospitals are located in areas of chronic poverty or acute disasters. Without these medicines, the hospitals are unable to respond adequately to medical needs.



2 *Pharmacy* \$100

You can help provide non-prescription medicines and health care materials for remote areas where there is no doctor or hospital. Materials include analgesics, oral rehydration drink, bandages, etc.



3 *BGR In-Home Care Kit* \$100

The BGR In-Home Care Kit is a compilation of medical and hygiene supplies packed into a five-gallon plastic bucket to help people suffering from terminal illnesses in poverty-stricken areas. Items in the kit make the caregivers' tasks much easier and ease the suffering of the dying.



4 *Tuberculosis patient treatment* \$250

Anti-Tuberculosis medications must be accompanied by food supplements in order to be effective. Your gift will help provide food supplements for TB patients.



5 *Medicine for a mobile clinic* \$2,500

Your gift will stock a mobile medical unit with a three-month supply of medications, basic supplies such as simple antibiotics and de-wormers administered by mobile medical staff.



6 *Healthcare and nutrition training* \$50

Your gift will provide food, training materials and transportation to and from a three- to five-day healthcare and nutrition training for local partners.



7

One mosquito net

\$5

Mosquito-borne diseases, such as malaria and dengue fever, can devastate a family. Not only can these diseases be life threatening, but they also can be costly in terms of resources to help save and provide recovery for a family member. Your gift of a mosquito net can help a family avoid calamities such as this.



MICRO-ENTERPRISE/MICRO-FINANCE

1

Initial set up of local business

\$100

As BGR teams train national partners in community development, seed money in small amounts can help provide capital for initial projects. These projects are chosen by the community and are often their first step out of poverty.



2

One local training

\$50

Your gift will provide food, training materials and transportation for a local partner participating in a three- to five-day training in micro-enterprise/micro-finance.



3

One sewing machine

\$35

A sewing machine can be the centerpiece of a micro-enterprise project that can help an individual provide for his/her family. BGR partners teach sewing skills using these machines. Those who learn to sew can help provide added income for the well-being of their families.



HIV/AIDS

1 *BGR In-Home Care Kit* \$100

The BGR In-Home Care Kit is a compilation of medical and hygiene supplies packed into a five-gallon plastic bucket to help people suffering from terminal illnesses in poverty-stricken areas. Items in the kit make the caregivers' tasks much easier and ease the suffering of the dying.



2 *Nutrition/food packet for HIV Victims* \$50

These food items are essential, especially to those taking anti-AIDS medicines (Anti-Retro Virals). Without good nutrition, the ARVs are not effective. If a family's wage-earner is sick, the rest of the family -- especially the children -- will suffer hunger.



WATER/SANITATION

1 *Water testing kit for worker* \$25

These workers will be trained by a BGR partner to recognize water problems in a community, provide consulting and testing of the water system, and offer simple and practical solutions to water problems. The kits will equip the partner, thereby helping prevent deadly water-borne diseases in their communities.



2 *Water well in war-torn area* \$8,000

The cost of development work escalates in war zones. However, impoverished people living war zones are often the least helped. Your gift will give people access to water in the most remote and dangerous places on earth.



3

Water system in developing country \$1,000

Water is one of the most basic human needs, but many villages in the developing world have no access to safe water. Each year, BGR helps almost 1,000 communities around the world gain access to safe drinking water. Your gift will provide a water system for a village.



4

One water filter for a family \$25

BGR partners help people learn how to make and market locally made "flower pot" water filters that are safe and economical to use. Your gift will help provide one filter from the factory to a home.



5

Toilet for a family or small community \$100

In both chronic and acute situations, rural as well as urban areas face serious sanitation challenges. Almost 25% of the world's population still lives without adequate sanitation. Your gift will help provide a simple latrine to a family or small community.



REFUGEES

1

Temporary shelter (tent) \$250

A critical need for refugees is a place for families to be safe, secure and out of the elements. Your gift will provide a temporary shelter such as a locally made tent or tarpaulin to protect refugees from the weather.



REFUGEES

2 *Cooking set for a displaced family* \$45

In many cases, refugees have no access to basic cooking facilities and utensils. Your gift will provide a cooking set for one family in need.

**3** *Permanent shelter for a family* \$2,000

As refugee situations stabilize, people are able to consider going home. Many times, however, their homes have been destroyed by looters or insurgents. Your gift will help them acquire a basic housing unit that is culturally appropriate and safe, allow a family to build and expand in subsequent years.

**4** *Small radio for a family* \$25

Often, radio provides the only outside news connection available to refugees who have lost everything. Your gift will provide a radio with shortwave capability (where available) that will help refugee families monitor emergency stations providing updates about the ongoing crisis.

**5** *Blankets for a family* \$20

Refugees are often housed in temporary shelters such as tents. Tents can be very, very cold in the cooler months. In cold climates, blankets are an essential item for refugee survival.



WIDOWS AND ORPHANS

1 *Food for a widow-headed family (1 month)* \$50

Your gift will supplement the basic staple foods a widow needs to care for herself, and in many cases, dependent children and/or grandchildren.



2 *Food for a child-headed family (1 month)* \$50

HIV/AIDS has devastated whole communities and regions, taking many parents from their families. Sub-Saharan Africa alone is home to 14 million orphans, many of whom live in a house where the oldest member is 14 years of age. Your gift will help provide the basic food staples and essentials for a child-headed household.



3 *Education for an orphan (1 year)* \$250

BGR's strategy keeps orphans in their homes and family settings by mobilizing the community to help take care of their needs. Your gift will help cover basic education needs, such as school supplies, uniforms, shoes and school fees, which orphans cannot afford.



HUNGER

1 *Food supplement for family (1 month)* \$50

Your gift will allow BGR partners to purchase local food and basic essentials that are both nutritionally balanced and culturally appropriate for a family caught in a chronic hunger situation.



HUNGER CON'T

2 *Hot meal for 5 children (1 week)* \$10

Your gift will help purchase and prepare locally available food and staples that are both nutritious and culturally appropriate. This one hot meal per day provides an important dietary supplement that ensures better health for children in need.



3 *Propane supply (1 month)* \$25

Impoverished families often have no fuel for cooking. Your gift will provide a means for families to obtain fuel to prepare their meals.
